

Clery Crime Alert

Burglary

On Saturday, February 8, 2025, at around 12:36 a.m. a Burglary occurred at 110 Morningside Drive, at the Morningside Campus.

A video review shows an individual using a device to gain entry to the building and removing several packages without permission or authority to do so.

The incident was reported to Columbia University Public Safety on Monday, February 10, 2025, at around 1:15 p.m. If you have any additional information about this incident, please contact the Department of Public Safety at 212-854-2797.

This same individual committed similar crimes on February 6, 2024, at 110 Morningside Drive.

The suspect is described as male presenting, with a light complexion, medium build, and wearing a brown puffer vest with checkers design at the front, black hoodie, khaki cargo pants, black sneakers, black backpack and carrying black and red trolley bag. There is no other information available at this time.

- Do not buzz people into a building unless you know who they are and what that are doing.
- Do not allow others to “piggyback” behind you into a secure location.
- Please try to retrieve your packages in a timely manner.
