Clery Crime Alert - Burglary

On June 4, 2024, at around 9:20 PM, Columbia University's Department of Public Safety received a report of a Burglary that occurred on June 4, 2024, at 4:10 PM at 540 West 112 Street at the Morningside Campus.

A Columbia University student reported their package was missing from the lobby of the building. The suspect is a light-complexioned male wearing a red t-shirt, tan pants and white sneakers. The suspect rang the building's intercom to gain entry and was buzzed in. Once inside he removed the package. The same subject is seen on CCTV entering 530 West 112 Street and tearing open a package. The subject was last seen walking westbound on West 112 Street, toward Broadway.
