

Clery Crime Alert

Burglaries

On Monday, July 08, 2024 at 9:45 p.m. and on July 14, 2024 at 8:13 p.m. two burglaries occurred at 521 West 112 Street, at the Morningside Campus.

The complainant, a Columbia University student, reported that two new air conditioners were removed from the lobby without permission or authority. Video review shows the same individual entering the building on both dates by piggybacking into the lobby. Once inside, the individual removes the property.

The incident was reported to Columbia University Public Safety on Tuesday, July 16, 2024 at 12:24 p.m. If you have any additional information about these incidents, please contact Public Safety at 212-854-2797.

The suspect is male-presenting, light-complexioned, and has short straight brown hair.
