Clery Crime Alert Attempted Robbery

On Sunday, August 18, 2024, at around 9:47 a.m. an attempted Robbery occurred at West 130th Street and Broadway, at the Manhattanville Campus.

The complainant, a non-affiliate, reported that they were walking south on Broadway at West 130th Street when two unknown persons approached from behind, displayed a firearm and demanded their property. The complainant attempted to run but was grabbed and thrown to the ground. No property was taken. The suspects fled East on West 130th Street and into the Manhattanville Houses.

One of the suspects was described by the complainant as male-presenting wearing a red hooded sweater, red sweatpants and red and white sneakers.

The second suspect was described by the complainant as male-presenting, wearing a black hooded sweater, black sweatpants and black sneakers.
