Burglary

On Friday, September 13, 2024 and Sunday, September 15, 2024, between 3:30 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. burglaries occurred at 528 Riverside Drive, at the Morningside Campus.

The complainants, both Columbia University students, reported their packages missing from 528 Riverside Drive. Video review shows an individual entering the building on September 13 at about 5:03 p.m., after ringing tenant doorbells. Once inside, the individual removes a package without permission or authority. Further video review shows the same individual entering 528 Riverside Drive on September 15 at 3:30 p.m. in the same manner and removing a package without permission or authority.

The suspect is dark-complexioned and wore a bike helmet, dark shorts, sneakers, and a delivery bag on their shoulders.

- Do not buzz people into a building unless you know who they are and what they are doing.
