



Clery Crime Alert

Burglary

The Department of Public Safety was informed of two burglaries that occurred on Friday, September 5, 2025. The first occurred at around 11:27 a.m. at 419 West 115th Street. The second occurred at 11:33 a.m. at 415 West 115th Street.

Both incidents appeared to have been committed by the same suspect, a female-presenting person, with a medium build and light complexion. They wore a dark Yankees baseball cap, black surgical mask, light purple pants, dark t-shirt, with "Naruto" printed on the chest, and red Nike sneakers. In each incident the suspect appears to have buzzed random apartments in an attempt to be let in, but was ultimately let in by a tenant leaving the premises.
