Clery Crime Alert Burglary

On Thursday, October 24, 2024, at 7:34 a.m., a burglary occurred at 507 West 113th Street, at the Morningside Campus.

The complainants, both Columbia University Students, had their packages taken from the lobby of 507 West 113th Street. A video review shows an individual entering the building on October 24, 2024, at about 7:34 a.m., by ringing the intercom to gain entry. Once buzzed in the individual removes two packages without permission or authority.

The suspect is the same individual from the Clery Crime Alert dated October 11, 2024.

The suspect is described as male presenting with a light build, short dark hair, and wearing a black and white checkered baseball hat, blue jeans, a gray sweatshirt with "POLO" across the front, white sneakers and a black backpack.

- Do not alloy others to "piggyback" behind you into a secure location.
- Please try to retrieve your package in a timely manner.
- Do not buzz people into a building unless you know who they are and what they are doing,
