Clery Crime Alert Burglaries

On Monday, November 18, 2024, between 5:40 p.m. and 5:50 p.m., two burglaries occurred. The first burglary occurred at 424-430 West 119 Street and the second at 110 Morningside Drive.

A video review shows an individual entering 424-430 West 119 Street on November 18, 2024, at about 5:40 p.m., ringing the intercom at random to gain entry. Once inside, the individual removed several packages. Further video review shows the same individual entering 110 Morningside Drive on the same date at 5:50 p.m. in the same manner and removing several packages without permission or authority.

The suspect is described as male presenting with a light build, dark complexion, white beard, wearing dirty worn blue jeans, and a blue hooded sweatshirt under a blue jacket and carrying black backpack.
