Clery Crime Alert Burglary

On Sunday, December 29, 2024, at around 6:41 a.m. a Burglary occurred at 500 West 122nd Street. At 6:48 a.m. a second Burglary occurred at 530 West 122nd Street.

A video review shows an individual entering the vestibule of 500 W. 122nd Street and removing several packages. The same individual then enters 530 W. 122nd Street and removes more packages after being buzzed into the building.

The suspect is described as female-presenting, with a slim build, medium complexion, and wearing a blue baseball cap, a blue jacket with a fur hoodie, blue jeans and black boots and pulling a black carry-on/piece of luggage. No other information is available at this time.

- Do not buzz people into a building unless you know who they are and what they are doing.
