If immigration comes to your residence, you can slip the bottom right portion of this flyer under the door or hold it up to the window. You can choose to not open the door and not sign any documents without speaking to a lawyer first.

## BUILDING SECURITY

- Ensure doors close and lock.
- Don't let unknown people in.
- Verify visitors before entry.
- Ask officials for ID/credentials.

- I am exercising my right to remain silent.
- I refuse to sign any documents without speaking to a lawyer first.
- I do not give you permission to enter my residence.
