## Clery Crime Alert Motor Vehicle Theft

Columbia University Public Safety was recently informed of a motor vehicle theft. The incident occurred on Monday, June 29, 2026, at approximately 3:02 a.m. in front of 611 West 112th Street.

The complainant, a non-affiliate, reported to the NYPD that they parked their vehicle on June 28, 2026, at approximately 8:00 a.m. When they returned on June 29, 2026, at approximately 4:00 p.m., they discovered the vehicle was missing.

### Description of Suspect(s):

The suspects were observed on CCTV and are described as male-presenting. Two suspects were wearing dark clothing, and the third was wearing a light-colored sweatshirt with a multicolored design on the front and back. They were seen operating a dark-colored Chevrolet SUV. No further information is available at this time.
