Robbery

Columbia University Public Safety was recently informed of a robbery that occurred at the Miracle Thai food truck located near West 117th Street and Broadway. The incident occurred on Thursday, July 9th, 2026, at approximately 1:16 PM.

The individual removed money from a tip jar belonging to the Miracle Thai food truck. A struggle ensued when a food truck employee attempted to recover the property. The individual was last observed entering the West 116th Street subway station.
